

PINE TREE DEVELOPMENT ZONES

The PTZ program offers eligible businesses the chance to greatly reduce, or virtually eliminate, state taxes for up to ten years when they create new, quality jobs in certain business sectors, or move existing jobs in those sectors to Maine. The program is administered by Maine's Department of Economic and Community Development.

TAX INCREMENT FINANCING

TIF is a tool that permits the City of Sanford to participate in local project financing by using some or all of the new property taxes from a capital investment within a district.

The City has the option of using the "incremental" taxes to reimburse a developer or business for a portion of development project costs.
